Carpool Reminders

We need your help! The neighborhood is complaining about the carpool line. We realize this is the first full week of school and we added kindergartners on Wednesday, but we need for all families to follow our carpool guidelines.

- ✓ Please do not walk up to pick up your child in the auditorium or the bus loop!
- ✓ Please do not block traffic on Thora. There must be a continuous traffic flow for our neighbors and/or emergency vehicles.
- ✓ No parking on the median on Thora.
- ✓ If your child is in 3rd; 4th, or 5th grade and there are no younger siblings, we need for you to drop-off and pick-up your child on Thora Blvd.
- ✓ If your child is in 3rd – 5th grade, you do not have to wait in the far right lane of Thora. You may go around that line of traffic and pull over just past the school driveway to let your child out in the morning or to pick-up from school in the afternoon.
- ✓ For Thora pickup, pull to the farthest spot available on the right side of the street in front of the students. If no spot is available, pull farther down and your child will be able to walk to you. No child will be allowed to walk into the street to be picked up.
- ✓ Please have your carpool tag hanging from the rearview mirror until your child has been loaded. The tag must have the **child's first name, last name and teacher's name.**
- ✓ Please alternate to allow traffic to flow freely from each side of Thora into the bus loop.
- ✓ Under no circumstances should you block the traffic on Line Avenue. If your car cannot turn completely onto Thora Blvd., please wait at the red light until you can turn.

If all families will follow these guidelines, remain calm throughout the first weeks of school, and be courteous to staff and other drivers, students will be safely delivered to your car! If this is too frustrating for you, please consider allowing your child to ride the bus each day. Thank you for your attention to these guidelines.
